

VETERANS DAY PARADE RULES

1. All entries must be in the lineup by 1:45 p.m..
2. All automobiles are required to be street legal and will not travel at a speed over five miles an hour. There will be no spinning of wheels, jump starting or other actions that may be harmful or dangerous to the parade spectators.
3. All floats must have persons stationed at each wheel, walking the parade route with the float for safety.
4. There will be no boom boxes playing (loud or obscene) music in parade.
5. There will be no Extreme 4x4 vehicles(Monster Trucks) or ATV's in the parade.
6. All entries will follow the entire route of the parade and disburse at the designated ending area. (Lucedale Elementary)
7. Any participant who operates a vehicle in the parade that poses danger to the crowd will be cited by the Police Dept. and will be removed from the parade.
8. All floats should have all decorations completed prior to lineup.
9. All decorations and/or music shall be Patriotic/Military.
10. All floats must be lined up at their assigned position.
11. No Horses/Animals will be allowed in the parade.

Candy throws will be allowed. Please help us Honor our Veterans with a Polite, respectful Parade.
