AND RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT


This Lucedale Christmas Parade Entry Agreement and Release and Indemnification Agreement is made and entered into this day between the City of Lucedale (hereinafter referred to as the "City"), the Lucedale Rotary Club (hereinafter referred to as the "Rotary Club") and \_\_\_\_\_ (hereinafter referred to as "Participant").

Rotary Club assists the City with the annual Christmas parade each year. The parade is scheduled for December 3, 2016. Participant desires to enter said parade this year with an entry of a marching group/float/vehicle/other entry into said parade.

By entering this parade and as a condition to participating in same, the Participant does agree to release and indemnify City and/or the Rotary Club for any and all liability, claims, demands, or potential liability actions, which may be filed against the City and/or the Rotary Club as a result of Participant entering said parade. By executing this Release, Participant does represent to the City and/or the Rotary Club that it has the full and complete authority on behalf of its members to execute this agreement. Participant further, on behalf of its members, hereby releases and waives any and all right or alleged rights at any time to ask for any damages, claim for which may be alleged against the City and/or the Rotary Club as a result of said parade.

Participant agrees to indemnify and hold the City and/or the Rotary Club harmless for any claim of any type whatsoever which may be made against the City and/or Rotary Club by any of the Participant's members, employees, agents, servants, guests, invitees, or persons on behalf of the Participant.

Participant acknowledges that the City and/or the Rotary Club assume no liability whatsoever by assisting in the presentation of this parade and specifically disclaims any liability whatsoever. By entering into this agreement, the Participant agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions hereof.

# PARADE RULES

1. All entries to be judged must be in the lineup at 4 p.m. judging starts at 4 p.m.
2. All automobiles are required to be street legal and will not travel at a speed over 5 miles per hour. There will be no spinning of wheels, jump starting or other actions that may be harmful or dangerous to the parade spectators.
3. All floats have persons stationed at each wheel, walking the parade route with the float.
4. All cars registered in the parade as antiques must be 1975 or before.
5. There will be no boom boxes in vehicles.
6. There will be no ATVs in the parade.
7. All parade entries will follow the entire route of the parade and disburse at the designated beginning area.
8. Any participant who operates a vehicle in the parade that poses danger to the crowd will be removed from the parade by the Police Department and will be removed from the parade. Large tire-raised vehicles must have someone walking by each wheel.
9. No Santa's, Please. The only Santa will be on the City Fire Truck.
10. Parade participants should park in the gated area at Lucedale Elementary and walk to the floats.
11. All floats should have decorations completed prior to lineup.
12. All floats must be lined up at their assigned position.
13. Parade participants must toss throws gently into the crowd. No hard or sharp throws are allowed which could cause injury.
