

ORDINANCE NO. 452

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 350 OF THE CITY OF LUCEDALE COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE TRANSIENT VENDOR ORDINANCE BY SPECIFY CITY SPONSORED EVENTS THAT WILL BE EXEMPT FROM THE PURCHASE OF A TRANSIENT VENDOR LICENSE

WHEREAS, the City of Lucedale has a substantial interest in protecting the businesses that are currently domiciled within the city limits; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lucedale has a substantial interest in protecting the rights of the public, its taxpayers and business owners by setting forth the events that are considered special events by the City; and

WHEREAS; a vendor would not be required to purchase a Transient Vendors License in order to participate in these events.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDANINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF LUCEDALE, MISSISSIPPI, as follows to wit:

SECTION 4: (k) AMENDMENT OF EXISISTING ORDINANCE LISTING OF EVENTS THAT ARE NOT SUBJECT TO THE PURCHASE OF A TRANSIENT VENDOR LICENSE:

Christmas Parade, Christmas Tree Lighting, Praise In The Park, Mardi Gras Parade, 2nd Saturday, Veteran’s Parade, Farmers Market, Oak Grove Block Party, and 4th of July Festivities (excluding Fireworks Vendors which are required to purchase a Transient Vendor License). The City reserves the right to amend or reduce this list through amendment at any time.

SECTION 2: This amendment Ordinance shall take effect 30 day from the date of its passage.




