Lucedale Christmas Parade Rules

PARADE THEME: CHRISTMAS THROUGH THE DECADES

All entries to be judged must be in line at 4:30 p.m. when judging starts. If you are not being judged floats must be in the lineup by 5 p.m. There will be prize money awarded to float winners.

All vehicles are required to be street legal and will not travel over 5 MPH. There will be no spinning wheels, jump starting or other actions that may be harmful or dangerous to the parade spectators.

All vehicles must be driven by a person that is insured with a valid drivers license.

There will be no ATVs or Golf Carts allowed in the parade. (All vehicles must be street legal)

****Even though the city has a ordinance that makes golf carts street legal, they are not allowed in the parade. ****

All floats will be required to have people stationed at each wheel, walking the parade route with the float.

****Even though new barricades will be lined up along parts of the route, walkers are still required****

Any participant who operates a vehicle in the parade that poses danger to the crowd will be removed from the parade route by law enforcement. Large tire/raised vehicles must have someone walking by each wheel.

All cars registered in the parade as antiques must be 2000 or before.

Any music played will be **CHRISTMAS MUSIC ONLY**. Music must not be played so loud that it drowns out music from a float in front or behind you.

All parade entries will follow the entire route of the parade and disburse at the designated area.

NO SANTAS PLEASE. The only Santa will be on the city fire truck at the end of the parade. If you do, you will be disqualified from judging and any parade activities.

If you do not follow the selected theme all entries must still have some type of decorations that display the Christmas spirit. This must be completed prior to lineup.

All entries must be lined up at their assigned position. Each float will be assigned a number which should be visibly displayed on the driver side door. Float numbers can be pre-picked up at Singing River Electric or will be handed out by a Rotary member as they arrive to line up for parade.

Parade participants must toss throws gently into the crowd. No hard or sharp throws are allowed which could cause injury.

Parade participants are to determine the best location for your organization to load your float to keep from causing traffic jams along the lineup.

Horses are not sponsored by the Lucedale Rotary Club.
